- 1. Be sure that SJSU has received an official copy of your final transcript(s).
  - a. If you have already submitted your final official transcript(s), please write "final transcript submitted" across the top of the affidavit.
  - b. If you have not submitted your official transcript(s) yet, please have your high school and/or community colleges submit them by one of the following methods:

If you are filing a <u>CA Dream Act Application (CADAA)</u> for financial aid consideration, the AB 540 affidavit is already included in the application. However, if you are not filing a CADAA and wish to be considered for the AB 540 Exemption, you must submit a <u>California Non-Resident Tuition Exemption Request Form</u>.
