





- 4-year regionally accredited Bachelor's degree
- 2.5 GPA (out of 4.0). Either cumulative or last 2 years of full-time study
- Good academic standing at the last institution attended
- English Language Proficiency (ELP) exam* (if applicable)
- Some departments may require a higher GPA and/or ELP score


