Overview and Vision

The SJSU Computer Science Department graduates approximately 300 students annually with BSCS, BSSE or MSCS degrees. These graduates are disciplined, creative programmers, versed in the latest technology and tempered with teamwork and communication skills. To facilitate industry engagement with students, graduates, and faculty, the department has created the Technology Partnership Program.

Partnership Opportunities

- Recruitment Opportunities Partners can recruit eager students in the informal atmosphere of monthly
 mixers, by giving brief in-class presentations, and by broadcasting positions through email.
- **Influence Opportunities** Partners can influence curriculum and research through student and faculty recognition awards, industry advisory board service, and research stipends.
- Enhancement Opportunities –Partners can enhance curriculum and research by sponsoring extracurricular programs, clubs, and coding competitions.
- **Marketing Opportunities** Partners can display their logo on the departmental web site (with a link to partner's site) and in the department's entry hall.
