

Terms and Conditions of Lower Division Transfer Admission | Fall 2024

Provisional Admission

This offer of provisional admission is based on the academic information you reported on your Cal State Apply application. All of your academic information must be verified. Your admission will remain “provisional” until your official, final transcript(s) passes verification.

This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. In addition, it is not possible to change your major prior to enrollment at SJSU. You must enroll in at least one course during the Fall 2024 semester to maintain your admission.

Mandatory Steps to Enrollment

To ensure your enrollment and attendance at SJSU, all of the mandatory steps below must be completed. Failure to do so will result in your admission being withdrawn, even if you have received financial aid, signed up for housing, attended orientation, or registered for classes.

Complete the Next Steps Intent to Enroll process by the date posted on your MySJSU To Do List

You must sign in to nextsteps.sjsu.edu and notify us of your Intent to Enroll by the date posted to your MySJSU To Do List.

1. Indicate that you accept SJSU's offer of provisional admission. Once you accept, you are making a commitment to attend SJSU and certify that you understand and agree to these terms and conditions.
2. Sign up for Spartan Experience for Transfers (SET), which is SJSU's mandatory orientation program for transfers.
3. Pay the nonrefundable enrollment deposit. Your nonrefundable enrollment deposit includes your Spartan Experience for Transfers orientation payment and a deposit toward a portion of your tuition and fees for Fall 2024.

Within three business days an email confirmation will be sent to you from the nextsteps@sjsu.edu email address. Print and keep this email—it is your Next Steps receipt for SET orientation. If you do not complete the multi-step Intent to Enroll Process by the deadline, we will withdraw your application.

Please contact nextsteps@sjsu.edu before the deadline if you encounter any obstacles to completing these steps.

Meet Math Enrollment Requirements

Your math enrollment requirement will depend on your major, completed mathematics coursework, test scores and other factors. You will receive a MySJSU message from Supported Instruction in the second week of May with further details. Attend mandatory Spartan Experience for Transfers (SET)

If you do not attend or leave during any portion of SET orientation you will be blocked from registering for classes and will not be able to attend SJSU in Fall 2024.

Meet the Requirements for lower division admission

An internal review (verification) of your application will be conducted. Your official, final transcript(s) must show that you meet the current impaction criteria and freshman admission requirements in order to pass verification. Failure to pass verification will result in your admission being withdrawn. To ensure your provisional admission passes verification, make sure your official, final transcript(s) meets the following criteria:

- Confirm the completion of all of your “a-g” college preparatory coursework with a grade of “C-” or better by the end of Spring 2024. SJSU will accept grades of “Credit” or “Pass” to satisfy “a-g” requirements completed during Winter, Spring, Summer or Fall 2020 terms and during Winter, Spring, or Summer 2021 terms. All prior coursework must be graded and a grade of “C-” or better must be earned for the course to satisfy “a-g” requirements.
- Confirm your date of graduation.
- Earn a minimum of 2.0 in all college coursework.
- Meet the current impaction criteria for your major for the Fall 2024 term.

Send your official, final high school and college transcript(s) postmarked no later than Monday, July 15, 2024

Send your official, final transcript(s), including grades for the Spring 2024 term, no later than July 15, 2024. Failure to submit your transcript(s) will result in your admission being withdrawn.

Send official test scores and or college transcripts needed to fulfill admission requirements by Monday, July 15, 2024

If you have taken and passed AP, IB or CLEP exams to satisfy any of the CSU admission requirements, request that your official scores be sent to SJSU by July 15, 2024. In addition, if you have completed courses at a community college, please order official transcripts to be sent to SJSU by July 15, 2024.
