WRITING CENTER MISSION

- Mission: To enhance the writing skills of SJSU students so they can communicate clearly in any setting (informal, academic, or professional)
- Tutoring = a collaborative experience in which both the student and the tutor are engaged; no proofreading or editing services
- Writers from all disciplines, of all grade levels, and during all phases of the writing process; assistance with any piece of writing
 - Projects
 - Essays
 - Proposals
 - Literature Reviews
 - Research Papers
 - Cover Letters
 - Resumes
 - Personal Statements, and much more...



TUTOR TRAINING

- All PEER tutors from various disciplines—from sophomores through graduate students
- Rigorous 15+ hour training program prior to being hired officially
 - Knowledge-base and pedagogy training
 - Multilingual learner training
 - Tutoring best practices
 - Observations
 - Role-playing (mock tutoring)
- Continued training at monthly meetings
- Continued observations with feedback
- Specialized training offered for tutoring online and working with graduate-level writers



SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

- Two 45-minute online tutoring sessions per week, with a third (additional) session being available upon request for graduate students
- Assistance with quick questions online through "Ask a Tutor" live chat service
- Scheduled in-person tutoring sessions and additional assistance with quick questions through drop-in tutoring (unavailable in fall 2020)
- Numerous resources posted online (most of which are created by our student tutors): http://www.sjsu.edu/writingcenter/writingresources
- Full slate of workshops every semester on topics ranging from "Common Grammar and Punctuation Errors" to "Basic APA Style" to "Body Paragraphs" to "Un-Blurring Plagiarism and Paraphrasing"
- Special programs, including writing groups/retreats for graduate students
- Writing contests and other events



WRITING CENTER/TUTORING MYTHS

All the following are common myths about writing centers (meaning that they are NOT true!).

- Writing Center tutors will edit/proofread/revise student papers.
- Writing Center tutors can only help with grammar.
- Writing Center tutors will ensure that every error is corrected in a piece of student writing.
- Students need to have a writing product already completed before they can visit a writing tutor.
- Only students in English/writing classes can visit the Writing Center.
- Undergraduate student tutors can't work effectively with graduate students.
- Only students majoring in English can be Writing Center tutors.
