- **CBAP Program: (b)** – Critical Bilingual Authorization Program sections taught with Spanish/bilingual education components. The Spanish bilingual seminar is taken twice, alongside student teaching with two different instructors.
- **\*MAT Degree:** \*The 30 units of coursework which make up the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT). Students may opt out of the MAT OR choose to complete it post-credential, within 7 years of starting the program
- *The Teacher Education Department determines the program plan and course sequence. Note that some courses must be taken concurrently with student teaching; the MAT courses must be taken sequentially.*
