- EDTE 262, 224, 294, 208, EDEL 108D, and EDEL 143P are offered in the summer, as well as the fall/spring. All other courses are fall/spring only.
- **CBAP Program**: (b) Critical Bilingual Authorization Program sections taught with Spanish/bilingual education components. The Spanish bilingual seminar is taken twice, alongside student teaching with two different instructors.
- *MAT Degree: *The 30 units of coursework which make up the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT). Students may opt out of the MAT OR choose to complete it post-credential, within 7 years of starting the program
- The Teacher Education Department determines the program plan and course sequence. Note that some courses must be taken concurrently with student teaching; the MAT courses must be taken sequentially.
