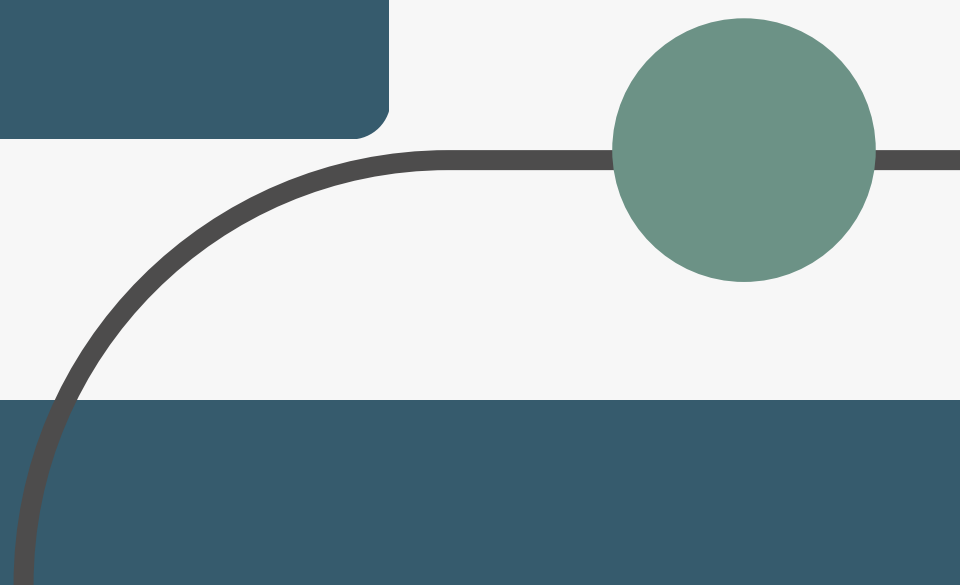

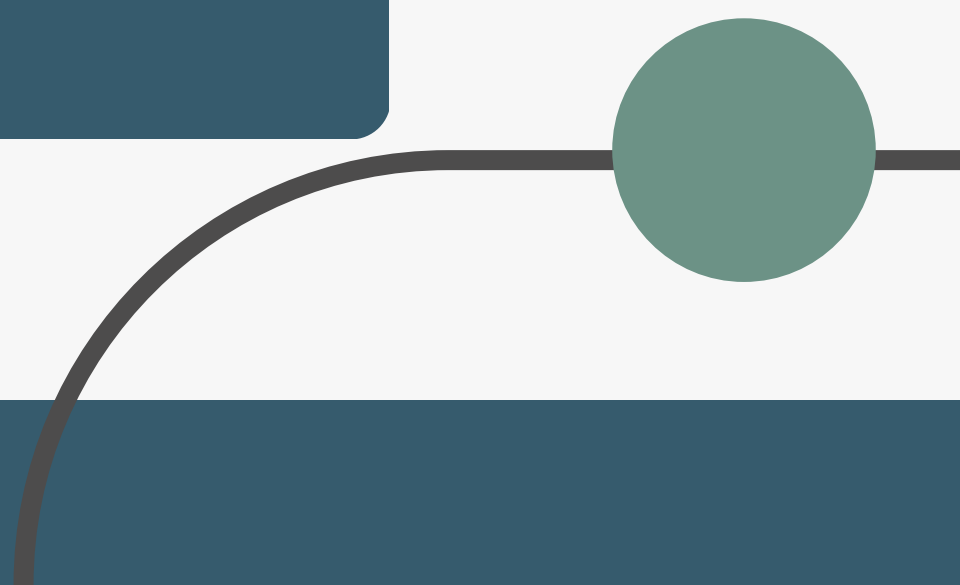


→ What is it? ←

- ...a type of AI that can generate content from the large pools of data on which it has been trained.
 - Content is generated based on probabilities, though some platforms may have embedded search functions.
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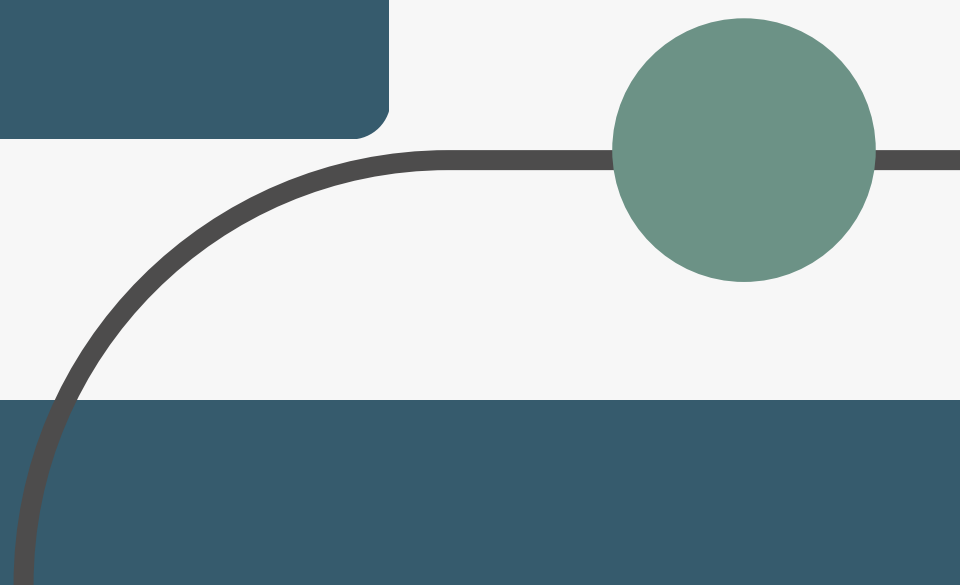


→ What can it do? ←

- generate text and/or images
 - respond to prompts
 - produce examples
 - summarize information
 - provide explanations
 - revise/edit content
- 



→ What can't it do? ←

- create new and original content
 - understand meaning
 - emote
 - verify truth

→ ChatGPT Edu ←

- LLM that uses text input and responds in a “human” manner.

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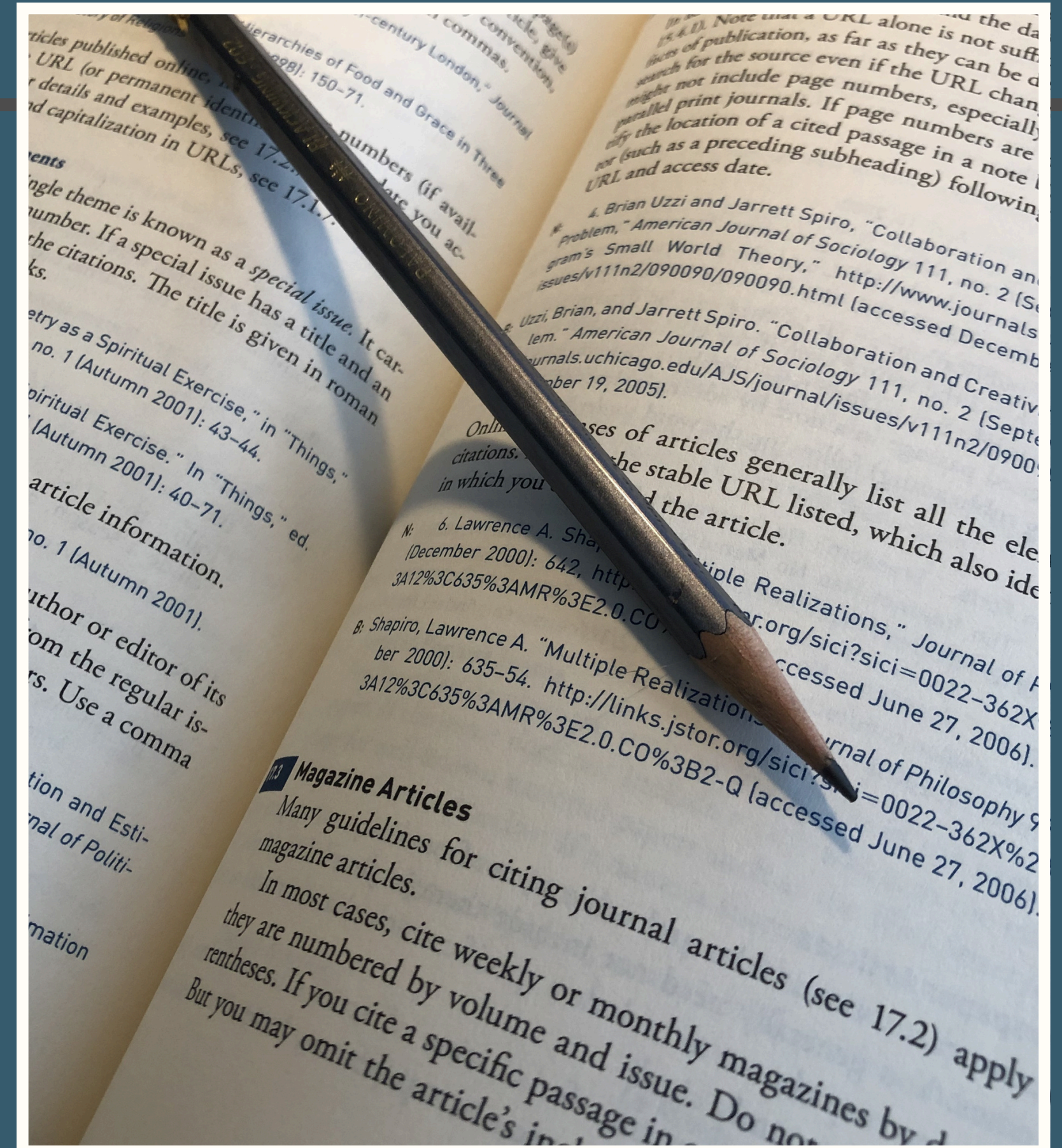

Language Around AI Use

How could using certain vocabulary to describe AI outputs be potentially problematic?



"NEW"

AI outputs aren't actually "new"-- they're generated based on patterns from the huge datasets that the model is trained on.



"CREATE"

Similarly, it's problematic to insinuate that AI can "create" anything--the act of creation is profoundly human, and the distinction needs to be emphasized to students.

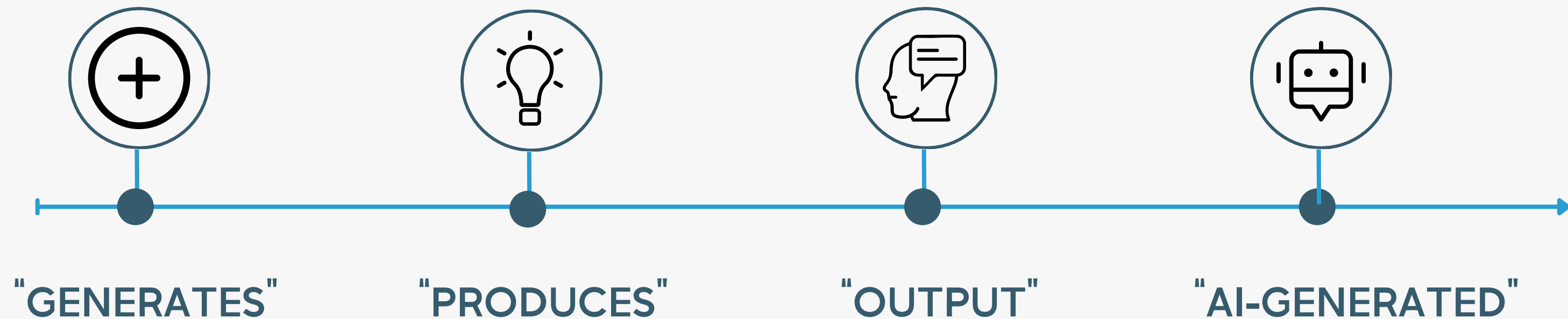


"WRITE"

Offhandedly saying that AI can "write" for you may give students the impression that it's okay to use AI outputs wholesale.

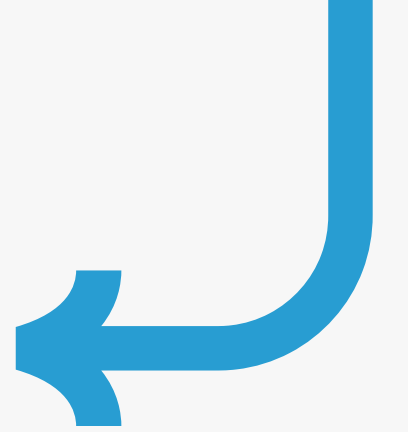
